WHAT IS OCC? Operation Christmas Child, a project of the international relief organization Samaritan's Purse, collects in the U.S and worldwide shoebox gifts filled with school supplies, hygiene items, and fun toys — and delivers them to children in need around the world. For many of these children, the gift filled shoebox is the first gift they have ever received. In 2017, Operation Christmas Child, the world's largest Christmas Child project of its kind, hopes to collect enough shoebox gifts to reach another 12 million children in over 100 countries. Since 1993, over 146 million shoebox gifts have already been collected in the U.S. and a few countries and delivered to children in over 100 countries. OCC along with the help of thousands volunteers and Samaritan's Purse — send all these wonderful shoebox gifts across the world to children in need and affected by war, poverty, natural disaster, famine and disease; and children living on Native American reservations and natural disaster impacted areas.

OCC WEEK—November 13-20, 2017

OCC holds annually National Collection week with nearly 5,000 drop-off locations open receiving shoebox gifts the third week of November.

HOW TO DONATE A SHOEBOX GIFT? Using a medium-sized cardboard shoebox or plastic shoebox, you can choose to pack for a **boy** or girl and if want, decide the age category: **2-4**, **5-9**, or **10-14**. Then fill your shoebox with new items such as small toys, a "wow" item, hygiene items, and school supplies. Please don't include: candy, toothpaste, used-damaged items, war-related toys, food or liquids (all due to shipping restrictions). You can choose to gift wrap shoebox, but just remember to not seal it closed (rubber bands around are ok). Some people also choose to enclose a personal note and picture with contact information.



To help defer shipping costs, please give a suggested donation of \$9.00 —either placing the donation in your shoebox, or use the online giving option Follow Your Box and then attach your printed label with tracking barcode on the outside lid of your shoebox so you can discover the country destination of your shoebox gift (under Look-Up Tool on samaritanspurse.org/occ or Mobil App). The same online donation and tracking barcode label can be used for multiple shoebox gifts (try not to tape over tracking barcode).
